**Announcing the 2018
Junior Researcher Open Zooarchaeology Prize**

The Junior Researcher Open Zooarchaeology Prize is awarded for the best open-access, open-licensed, digital contributions to zooarchaeology from papers or posters presented at an ICAZ International Conference. The competition is open to all ICAZ 2018 Ankara conference participants who are students or have received a degree (Ph.D., MA, or BA/BS) within the past 10 years. The top two contributions will be determined by a panel of judges, based on scholarly merits and potential for reuse in research and teaching. All contributions will be posted on the Web, linked to their conference abstract in BoneCommons. The 2018 competition is sponsored by the Alexandria Archive Institute, working to increase the breadth and depth of scholarship in archaeology on the web; and ISD, distributor of scholarly and specialist books.

WHO MAY COMPETE

To be eligible, all content must be provided under licensing terms no more restrictive than the Creative Commons Attribution License (see details below). Open licensing terms will help maximize the impact of your research and ensure that others can build on your contributions.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

To enter, email your paper/poster text and related images/slides to Sarah Witcher Kansa, the competition organizer at (sarahkansa@gmail.com). Please use the subject heading ***Junior Researcher Open Zooarchaeology Prize Entry***. In the body of the email, include your contribution's title, the title of the session in which you presented it, and the license you have selected for it (CC 0 or CC Attribution).
